Benefits of enrolling in an accredited ventilation course

All courses offered by MVA are now available in fully-accredited versions through TAFE Queensland (TQ Mining Services) as part of the Australia-wide Vocational and Educational Training (VET) network.

Benefits of enrolling in the accredited version of a course include:

- The student obtains a qualification listed in the Australian Qualification Framework (AQF). This includes issuing of a Statement of Attainment (certificate of competency).
- The qualification is nationally-recognised and therefore “portable” across States and Territories under the “mutual recognition” legislation enacted by all Australian jurisdictions
- The student has been assessed to a consistently-applied national competency “standard”. Unlike non-assessed courses, the mine manager can be confident that the student can actually understand and apply the knowledge given at the course in a practical way
- The student him/herself can also be confident that he/she meets an assessment standard used across Australia for that course. The student will have used their new skills in completing the assignment(s) in a situation away from both the training environment and the course presenters.
- Students intending to take up a role as Ventilation officer, Planning Engineer or the like, or a longer-term career as a ventilation specialist, will benefit from obtaining the formal accreditation
- As accredited courses do not attract GST, the additional cost for the fully-accredited course is often only marginally above the cost for the non-accredited version
- There is minimal “paperwork” or time delay in enrolling via TAFE Queensland (TQ Mining Services)
